CBE Report Card Example

Each subject has proficiency indicators that are taught and assessed. Some proficiency indicators are taught and assessed over multiple marking periods, while others span a single marking period. Cumulative grades are calculated by averaging the proficiency scores for each marking period where the proficiency is assessed.
