Lent (6 Sundays and all weekdays have masses)

Palm Sunday (=Lent 6, beginning of Holy

Week)

Maundy Thursday Good Friday

Holy Saturday

Central feast Easter (date varies)

Period of rejoicing Easter week

Sundays after Easter

Ascension day (Thursday, 40 days after Easter)

Sunday after Ascension

Closing feast Pentecost (50 days, with octave)

Variable, "green" period Sundays after Pentecost ... (until Advent)
